All of these seniors are still very active in their countries and an outstanding example of Kase Ha Shotokan Ryu. The week after the Gasshuku there was an examination of 12 shodan and nidan from Belgium in the Honbu Dojo in Hasselt.



During the months of June, July and August courses were organized in Espinho (Portugal - Filipe Sancho), Jerez (Spain - Sergio Salazar), Aberdeen (Scotland - Brian Bothwell), Cadiz (Spain - Juan Pablo Delgado), Sonkajärvi (Finland - Raimo Lappalainen and SKF). In August there was the summercourse in Hasselt with the attendance of 6 Polish karateka's (headed by Greg Konieczka) and there was a course scheduled in Cork, Ireland (Tim Harte). The standard of the participating karateka's is on a serious level. This way everybody can improve and train with qualified partners.

Message from Shihan Dirk Heene 9th Dan, President of the KSKA

We should not forget to keep the standard from our typical Kase Ha methodics and kata's. Ten no kata, Heian ura and go, Heian oyo and Tekki oyo. The training from O, Chu and Ko waza connected with hente skills, the open-hand basics and gyaku uraken drills.


Message from Tom Van Achte, Secretary of the KSKA

Dear Members,

This newsletter was planned for August, but it was slightly delayed to September, there were various reasons for that. You can again find in this issue course reports, pictures, announcements and flyers of upcoming courses. I want to thank everyone who contributed to this. You will probably notice that all but 1 report were written by me. That also means, if I would not have written the reports, there would have been 1 course report only... So once again : **if you recently organized a course and there is no report in this newsletter,** I want to encourage you to appoint someone to make some pictures and send me a (small) report, so next time your course can also appear in the newsletter. You will also find all available information for the second Gasshuku of 2023, Dippoldiswalde (close to Dresden) October $6^{th} - 8^{th}$ and info about the first Gasshuku of 2024, Liverpool. After a warm welcome to the many participants, both members and non-members, the first session (friday evening) for all attending was led by Shihan Dirk Heene. After a good warm-up the first theme can be described as 'basic KaseHa karate'. Does that mean it is easy? No, not at all. Is it basic? Well, the principles explained by Shihan Dirk were basic, the application of basic principles however ... can quickly evolve into something rather difficult. Very interesting topics for all karateka to study and to work on in the (near) future.



Both the saturday sessions were split up (members and non-members), members had their first session of the day with Sensei Jim Martin, non-members enjoyed 2 training sessions with Sensei Juan Pablo Delgado and Sensei Nico Ibscher.

Sensei Jim's focus was on the 4th Dan program, after warming up the training was divided into 2 main parts, 1 part focussing on the gyaku uraken program (with all the different movements in many directions), the second part focussed on 3 combinations at 4th Dan level, including some interesting kumite training and applications.



The second saturday session for members was led by Sensei Michaylo Fedyk, the theme of this training was learning / training a combination of kata Nijushiho and Nijushiho ura (combined), quite a challenge for body and mind as all the movements of the kata need to be executed both left and right (but not necessarily starting left).

The day continued with the Dan grading of many candidates (also mentioned on page 01 of this newsletter), a Shihankai meeting and finally the course dinner in the all you can eat (world cuisine) Wok Dynasty (yes, there was a lot of eastern food). The course dinner was very well attended (with over 80 people) and at the end of the dinner Shihan Dirk Heene congratulated all the members who graded (and all of them passed). There was a good atmosphere of international friendship and many happy faces were seen that night. The only strange thing that night was a dish robot who got stuck most the time... technology, always big fun you know.

Sunday morning was 1 combined session (for all attending) led by Sensei Pascal Petrella, who gave a very high level (brain)training of kata Sochin.




Well, it meant: kata Sochin omote 2x, ura 2x, go 2x, ura-go 2 times, then the oyo-version and finally bunkai with multiple partners. Of course not only slow. Everyone seemed fully aware of his/her own limitations somewhere during this training.

Training Weekend, Jerez de la Frontera (Spain)

June 2nd – 4th, Sensei Dirk Heene



The main theme of this course was the kata Heian Oyo (both form and applications).

Training Weekend (Trainingslager) Dippoldiswalde (Germany) June 10th – 11th, Sensei Juan-Pablo Delgado



The small, beautiful and (usually) quiet village of Reichstadt (near Dippoldiswalde) might have felt some little earthquakes during the sunny weekend in June because of the joined kiai's and kime of all participants to the trainingslager (training weekend) under the guidance of Sensei Juan Pablo Delgado. Also a few other members of his club attended the sessions and actively supported their Sensei, who can really use his demonstrations of techniques and his voice to motivate you to go just that little further, harder, faster, ...

The weekend actually started on Friday evening with an outdoor training in the private outdoor Dojo of Sensei Nico Ibscher on invitation. A very nice experience it was for us (the Belgians who also joined this training weekend) to train outdoors, barefoot and in sports outfit (no karate-gi). The theme of that training was kata Heian Oyo and of course many applications with (constantly rotating) partners.

A lot of training sessions happened on Saturday with Sensei Juan Pablo, teaching the lower grades and higher grades. The main course theme was kata Jitte, as some of Nico's members were preparing for grading Nidan in october at the upcoming Gasshuku in Dippoldiswalde. However, on Saturday the higher grades trained a lot of open hand combinations and kumite combinations but never did the actual kata. A very interesting point was the studying of an alternative to gyaku uraken: gyaku shuto (starting high up – jodan and gradually going down to gedan, very much like a cut with a katana).

On Sunday the higher grades then concluded the weekend with the kata Jitte + bunkai.

A special thanks to Sensei Nico Ibscher and everyone who helped, we experienced a great sense of hospitality and international friendship. Who else puts a big tent next to the open barbecue place in the garden to enjoy eating and drinking together all weekend long? Report by Tom Van Achte, your Secretary.

International Course, Espinho (Portugal)

June 23rd – 25th, Sensei Dirk Heene

Last June in the city of Espinho, between Porto and Aveiro area, Portugal, the annual Kase Ha Shotokan Ryu Karate Do International Course organized by the ESKHA – Escolas Shotokan Kase Ha, a member of the Associação de Karaté do Porto (Porto Karaté Association), from the KSKA members Sensei Armando Reis, Sensei Filipe Sancho and Sensei Orlando Gonçalves took place, once again with the usual teaching of Sensei Dirk Heene.

Participating on the course was a great group of ESKHA – AKP students, among them were also the students of Sensei Luís Figueira, also a member of ESKHA – AKP which follows Kase Ha way, but that couldn't join the course.

Also participating were the Portuguese KSKA instructors, Sensei Miguel Rocha, Sensei Henrique Carriço and Sensei Lionel Tavares, from the CKA – Centro de Karaté-Do de Aveiro, from this group Sensei João Santos couldn't join this time, as normally he does, but did a great effort sending his

students. A great group of instructors and students under the supervision of these KSKA instructors joined the course.

Also, we must refer to Sensei Vítor Ramalho, a former member of KSKA, that for a long time followed our way and joined the course with his students. Another former member of KSKA joined the course, Sensei Joaquim Pacheco, it's always very good when we feel that the connection is still there.

Finally (and very important) a strong group from Belgium joined as well, Alex and Marina Smolders and Ward Vanswijgenhoven, they did a great effort coming and supported the course with their fantastic attitude and spirit.

To all these people mentioned the organization wants to show an enormous gratitude, but also to the ones that couldn't join, but whose great spirit was with the course, and to ESKHA – AKP students that gave a great support on the logistics side.



During Friday evening training Sensei Dirk introduced the theme for the weekend, some basic movements were trained and tested with partner aiming to the purpose of the rest of the weekend, which was introducing the Heian Oyo concept to the lower grades and Bassai Dai Go to the higher grades.

The Saturday morning sessions were divided into two groups, up to 4th Kyu, but open to higher grades and from 3rd Kyu and above.

In the first session, with the lower grades, Sensei Dirk introduced the first blocks of Heian Oyo, starting with an additional block to the right side using the second block of Heian Shodan, meaning Gedan Barai, Tetsui and Oi Tsuki. Sensei Dirk explained the group that this first block is not a part of Heian Oyo, but that he finds it interesting to start with, specially when introducing the concept of Heian Oyo to lower grades.

After the technical introduction of the initial blocks of Heian Oyo the group was organized in partners and the application of these blocks was tested in a fighting situation.

A lot of very young students wanted to join the course and meet Sensei Dirk, for these young students the interpretation became a little bit difficult, and Sensei Dirk had to simplify the training for them, but these young students were very happy for the chance to meet and train with him, for them it was a unique experience that they will never forget and it was great to see Sensei Dirk giving them great attention.

Several instructors and higher grades joined this session, which was good for everyone, and it was great to see the instructors training and supporting the lower grades, especially the young kids.

The second Saturday morning session was for the higher grades, as per the introduction done on Friday, the theme was Bassai Dai Go. The Kata was divided into two parts, in this session Sensei

Dirk taught the first part, then the applications, first with one partner, but then in groups of 3, first each block isolated, but finally all blocks together.

On Saturday afternoon there was no training and everyone could enjoy the city of Espinho and the beach, this same day was São João (Saint John) day and the atmosphere in the area was festive. In the evening a course dinner was organized and a great group joined, these moments are always important as well, bringing the Kase Ha family and friends together in a different environment than training, allowing everyone to share other things of their own lives and another unique moment to hear Sensei Dirk sharing moments that he lived with Sensei Kase.

Sunday morning sessions were also divided into two groups, same as on Saturday. In the first session with the lower grades Sensei Dirk continued with Heian Oyo and more applications. It was not possible to finalise the whole Kata, mainly because the idea kept by Sensei Dirk for the participants was that it would be better to learn less, but understand it better, than to try to learn the whole Kata, but not understanding it at all. This idea was great and everyone realised this approach helped in understanding the theme.

The second session, with the higher grades, Sensei Dirk continued with the second part of Bassai Dai Go and respective applications. Then again, all parts were tested with one partner and in groups of 3. Sensei Dirk enhanced the importance of learning the form and improve the technique, but then test everything in Kumite situations, otherwise a very important part of understanding a Kata would be lost. The session ended with everyone doing the whole Bassai Dai Go.

On Sunday morning the group received the visit of Sensei António Gomes, from Shito Ryu, the general technical director of the Associação de Karaté do Porto, who dedicated a few words of gratitude to Sensei Dirk and everyone joining the course.

The organization wishes to thank Shihan Dirk Heene for his great teaching and support, his attitude and experience brings unity to the group and motivates to keep evolving.

Next year (2024) the course is already scheduled from the 21st to the 23rd of June.

If you want to experience the warmth of the Spanish summer, Spanish hospitality, the sea breeze, an old city with lots of cultural heritage and combine that with traditional good food and an intensive karate course with many topics and instructors, then you probably should have been in Cadiz July 6th – 9th. The mixed feeling of holiday atmosphere with intensive training is unique. If you have never experienced it, try to attend this course next year.







The different instructors during the course brought a lot of topics to work on, so the training sessions had a lot of variation.

The Friday morning training at the beach was a very special moment, where we trained as the sun was setting and you could feel the connection with nature, you could smell the salty sea water, there was some fog coming from the sea and finally the sun started getting more powerful and all clouds dissappeared to end the training in bright sunlight.



On Saturday evening there was the course dinner, this time it happened on the beach, where we could watch the sun go down, eat local food and drink (whatever you wanted) until 23h00. This all happened in a very friendly international atmosphere amongst karate friends and family. International it was for sure with people attending from Spain, Israel, Germany, Belgium, Luxembourg, Portugal and other countries.




