### Message from Shihan Dirk Heene 9th Dan, President of the KSKA


#### Dear Members,

The August newsletter comes in the middle of the summer holidays, or for some the holidays are over. Many clubs are closing for July and August and it is not good to completely stop training for 2 months. There were some intensive courses in Poland, Chlúchów (14-15 June) and in Portugal, Espinho (20 – 22 June) and the Cadiz course in Spain from 3 to 6 July was real success. In Cadiz a great number of instructors were involved, so many Kase Ha subjects were presented. Heian nidan oyo bunkai, as well as Jiin were deeply analysed by Dirk Heene and Juan Pablo Delgado. Jim Martin focused on Jitte and Pascal Petrella on Naihanchi Nidan (version from Steve Cattle). The combination of sun and sea with the beach training makes this course very attractive. Juan Pablo arranged this event splendidly, providing many training sessions filled with a lot of information.

Immediately after I left for Finland for the Kesäleiri (summer course). It really was a summer course with a heat wave from around 30 °C lasting for 20 days.

In the Honbu Dojo in Hasselt (Belgium) the training sessions continued during summer 3 days a week





and were led by different instructors: Mario Van Roy, Gert Ballet and Dirk Heene. The dojo is opened every day, so everyone can train random, this is not possible everywhere. In August 22 to 24 we had the summer course in Hasselt with possibility to stay overnight in Honbu Dojo.

I hope to see you at our Gasshuku in Luxembourg on 10 till 12 October. Keep well and train regularly.

### Message from Tom Van Achte, Secretary of the KSKA


### Dear Members,

The second weekend of May 2025 many members and other karateka travelled to the beautiful city of Helsinki, the Capital of Finland to attend the first Gasshuku of 2025 held from Friday May 9<sup>th</sup> till Sunday May 11<sup>th</sup>. For some of us it was relatively cold outside, day temperature was somewhere between 5 and 10 degrees Celcius and that needed some adjusting. At least the snow was (already) gone.

The training hall was located under the Helsinki Olympic Stadium. It turned out to be a modern, light wooden spacious training hall with all you can expect from a modern facility, very comfortable. The staff of the Olympic Stadium were also very friendly and helped out with whatever request we had because the KaseHa Finland (responsible for organising this Gasshuku) made sure everything was taken care of and translated into Finnish. Very nice for people that do not



really understand the language (like me, for example). Shihan Dirk Heene of course was the big exception, but this of course had to do with the fact that he has a deep connection with Finland and KaseHa Finland, as he is teaching 4 times a year (once every season) somewhere in Finland (as you can see on the calendar in this news letter and on the KSKA website).




The first session (open to all attending) on Friday evening was led by Sensei Juan Pablo Delgado. Theme of this training was kata Jiin (omote, go and applications). As usual the buildup of the training was very good, well structured and very interesting applications were shown, explained and trained. For all details we would like to refer you to the course DVD, more info further in this newsletter.

The first session on Saturday for the KSKA members was led by Sensei Jim Martin, focussing on kihon and kumite combinations, starting with a very interesting combination of 8 attacks / blocks with open hands that were indeed 'easy' if you understand and train the motorics of the movement. But for people who are not used to this kind of combinations a lot of concentration and focus is needed to pull it off. Of course there were



excellent demonstrations, that also really helped. Afterwards techniques in different directions were added, more blocks and kicks opened the doorway to applications in kumite. Very interesting and challenging for most participants. It was a lot to take in for most members, but very valuable information to train on and to further develop your karate.

At the same time the non-members enjoyed a good training session with Sensei Mike Fedyk.



The members were trained by Shihan Dirk Heene, focussing on using O-waza, chu-waza and ko-waza (normal distance, middle distance and short distance technique) in attacks and



blocking / counter-attack combinations. Not so easy to perfom the combinations correctly with good kime and zanshin. This was also a focus point during the training session.

The Yearly KSKA General Assembly also happened on Saturday afternoon 17h00 in the hotel where the Shihankai and Executive Committee members stayed. A detailed report of this annual meeting can be found on the KSKA website, as always.


On Saturday evening, the traditional course dinner was held in a busy 'all you can eat' restaurant (part of the restaurant was reserved for our big group, as most karateka participating in the Gasshuku also attended this dinner, sometimes with their relatives travelling with them). The menu was a combination of Argentinian (delicious grilled foods) and Asian cuisine (sushi, wok, etc...) all you can eat. During the dinner many stories were told, there were many laughs, it was (and is) a great way to connect with each other.



The Sunday session (and last session of this Gasshuku) was a group training with everyone, led by Sensei Pascal Petrella, focussing on kumite. All the energy that was left in the participants bodies was used to go all out during this intense training session. If you want more details, we kindly remember you that you can always order the DVD of this course to further study and train all the aspects of this training session (and the 3 other training sessions of course).

Report by Tom Van Achte, your Secretary.



I arrived quite early, actually before all the other foreign participants in this, the 21st. Kase Memorial, in memory of our beloved teacher Kase Sensei, who passed away on 24/11/2004. It is now a firmly entrenched tradition that during every last or one before last weekend in May every year, this training weekend takes place in Hasselt, where one of Kase Sensei's top pupils, Dirk Heene Shihan hosts us at his Dojo in honour of his Mentor.

As always in the past, the comfortable rooms and service at the Holiday Inn Express were ready for the karateka coming from their various destinations, as well as the hospitality of the Honbu Dojo itself and various private dwellings of supporters and friends of the KSKA. My Israeli colleagues, Arie and Leonardo, (who will be teaching sessions at the next Kase Memorial in Hasselt in 2026) arrived after me and I greeted them heartily as soon as their feet crossed the threshold of the hotel.

Shihan Dirk Heene, in my experience is the best Karate mind I have ever known. Never ever can I remember having had the same lesson twice from him, in the 25 years I trained with him before leaving Belgium. It is a true tribute to Dirk Heene, as I have had the fortune to train with many great teachers, including Kase and Shirai Sensei, in the 40 years I have been training, since first entering a karate Dojo at the (quite) advanced age of 38. Never repeating exactly the same lesson twice, is a unique achievement, of which I know no other teacher than Dirk Heene, ever to have accomplished this.

I hadn't trained for 2 years due to some health problems and was quite apprehensive as to what I would be physically capable of, due to a much-reduced fitness-level. I work out somewhat at home, but that is not sufficient, to equal over such an extended period, the 2 or 3 one-and a half-hour sessions most KSKA members do under normal circumstances.


The excitement of meeting all my old friends, whom I only communicate with nowadays on Facebook, such as Yvette (many thanks for the impeccable administration of the course!), the various Toms from Belgium and Tonis from Finland, as well as Raimo, Jarmo and so many others that it would lengthen this text far too long, for the patience of those, trying to read it. So, I'll just say, that I was very excited, especially because I knew that I was going to make new friends, as at every Gasshuku as well.

And I wasn't wrong. There were karateka from all over, who were expected; Belgium, the host country (of course), Finland, Poland, Portugal, Scotland, Israel (from which now, yours truly) and others of which I'm not sure (like Netherlands, Germany, United Kingdom). A truly international gathering, where even though combat was an essential part, peace was the ultimate aim.

The teachers of the 3 groups, according to their rankings (Coloured belts, First Dan and second Dan up,) would be taught alternatively by Jarmo



Niiranen Sensei, Jim Martin Shihan and Dirk Heene Shihan. As I suspect is usual, the programme might have been discussed by our teachers beforehand, so that there would be a common theme, for all the levels to recognize.





That was the order of things. The highest-level started with a lesson by Jarmo Sensei. It consisted of open-hand Hente (same-side) blocks adding kizami Geri-Waza (legtechniques using the front leg). Not easy, especially for the older ones among us, but in general it went very well. Then we partnered up for the Kihon Kumite of these techniques. Jarmo Sensei briefly touched upon Ibuki (breathing), which enhances the pulmonary output of the combatants and is a very important part of all Martial Arts.

I worked with a young Portuguese Karateka, the young man's name, who was an excellent partner, was a little difficult for me to remember, but if I reveal that he was 26 years old and that he had a neat beard, that might help in identifying him. He was really good. We changed partners during the session and I also teamed up with old friends during these efforts. To finish our first lesson, Jarmo Sensei, had us work up to the end of the first half of Kata Chinte and its Bunkai.

Dirk Shihan and Jim Shihan gave us the next two lessons. They were basically on the same theme as Jarmo Sensei and especially focussed on distance. Dirk Shihan concentrated on Chu, Ko and O waza, medium, short and long distance blocking, followed by 3 open-hand counters and Uraken (backfist, a lethal technique when well applied). We then practiced this, first with one, then two and even up to multiple attackers.

This is also where I met, whom I can only describe as a fantastic young Karateka from Portugal, still only in her early twenties, already a second Dan and a real Champ, who opened my eyes to what Kime (focus, speed and strength combined) means. Andrea, despite my advanced age, I hope to soon, yet again, have the privilege to face you and learn from you, in the Dojo, what real Kihon Kumite (amongst other things) is.

Jim Shihan and his Sempai, Gerry McGeoch Sensei, continued teaching us the Kase Ha, that he is so well-known and admired for, in the same spirit and concentration that Jarmo Sensei and Dirk Shihan had started with. Jim's Karate is at such a uniquely high level, that there are no words (in my book anyway) to describe it. And what I always say, is that he is such a modest person, that he doesn't even realize it. "Pure genius," is how I have heard his teaching described by more people than I can mention here.

We also had time to relax, socialize and reminisce about times past. At the dinner the foreign contingents were invited to (by their excellent Belgian hosts) I heard many stories about past training sessions and Gasshuku in distant places and stories about the past history of incidents that happened a long time ago, which is a good thing to remember, as the famous saying "History repeats itself," needs to be known by the new generations (yes in Karate too), as some of the "old"





Anyway, the dinner was also a time to get to know people face-to-face that I only knew from Face-book, including Marcin Zawada Sensei from Poland, who attained 4th. Dan at the grading and to whom I extend sincere congratulations, as well as to all the others who continued advancing to higher levels in the exams that they passed.

The fourth and last training session for 2nd. Dan and up was again given to us by Jarmo Sensei. The theme was "Kase no Sanchin" with emphasis put on 5 "Ibuki" breathing phases. One only actually encounters what is called Breathing Kata in original Shotokan in the Kata Hangetsu, and this is much more common in other Ryu than in traditional Shotokan and KaseHa. We added to our Oi Tsuki attacks Hente ones (Tate and Ura Tsuki) followed by Okuriashi Mawashi geri and Kaiashi Yoko Geri Kekomi, in the Kata Kumite of this Kata that Kase Sensei adapted to his own Kase Ha Shotokan Ryu.


To finish we then did the second half of Kata Chinte, with the Oyo Bunkai, applied form. Unfortunately I didn't actually train the last session, as slightly injured, but I watched and learned from the sideline of the very active training-hall.

Let me finish this little report, by saying what wonderful teachers we have in the KSKA. Even though both Dirk Shihan and Jim Shihan are quite advanced in age and Jarmo Sensei a lot younger (and here I mustn't forget other teachers of the Academy, who couldn't be with us,) one clearly sees in the way they all teach the line and tradition, that Kase Sensei initiated more than 75 years ago and the continuation of his unique Budo (way of the Warrior) techniques, which though evolving, still stick to his basic philosophy.

And so we all said goodbye, till the next Gasshuku or other training weekends, all returning to our homes with our muscle memories recharged, till we meet again. It was a great experience, especially for me, who hadn't trained in group for such a long time.

For the 25<sup>th</sup> time (a jubilee!), the International Summer Course took place in the wonderful coastal city of Cadiz, Spain from July 3<sup>rd</sup> till 6<sup>th</sup>. The 4 Shihankai members presented a big variety of topics during the 4 days, so we all went home with more things to work on and improve.

It was a wonderful progression of themes: kata heian nidan (+bunkai also for lower belts) by Shihan Dirk Heene, kata tekki shodan and bunkai (Sensei Francois Van Binst), kata jitte and



bunkai (Jim Martin), kata jiin and bunkai (Sensei Juan Pablo), kumite and kata naihanchi nidan, the Steve Cattle version (Sensei Pascal Petrella) and some other topics were touched upon by all sensei under Spanish heat in a sports hall with little or no cooling or at the seaside (as usual on friday morning, training at the beach).


This year there also was a fun activity after the beach training on Friday. People who wanted to, could try surfing the waves of the sea with instructors. 




